奈良

- 奈良东大寺-是日本最有名和历史上最重要的寺庙之一, 同时它也是奈良的地标建筑及世界上最大的木结构建筑。
- 神鹿公园-公园内巨树林立, 还有历史悠久的古迹、花草、山林及岩石等, 有驯鹿成群, 共有1,200多只, 散布於山间、林下或寺庙的池畔, 是奈良观光的象徵。

大阪

- 大阪城堡-是大阪的象徵, 它包括十三处被日本政府立为重要文化遗产的建筑。
- 心斋桥商店街-大阪最大的购物区, 也是日本最长的天篷式购物街, 集中了许多精品屋和专卖店还有很多饮食店, 既有日本菜, 也可以品尝到中国、韩国、亚洲、美洲和欧洲等世界各个国家、各个地区不同的风味呢。

京都

- 清水寺-历史悠久的寺庙, 整座建筑完全不用铁打钉琐。沿途坡道两旁是日式古老建筑及商店, 摆满了各种各式的日本手工艺品, 陶瓷, 日本娃娃等, 不胜枚举。
- 祇园艺妓街-讲到京都就会联想到祇园。在道路的两旁是纵横方向能通风的用细细的方材建成的格子窗, 大街的格调与舞妓的风采十分相称。街上排列着销售发簪、香和日式服装装饰物品等京都特有的商店。
- 伏见稻荷神社-是位于京都南面的重要神社。以其主建筑物后成千上的朱红鸟居门闻名。山径延伸进入神圣的稻荷山, 山高233米。稻荷是神道教诸神中的农业之神, 而狐狸被视为是神的使者。因此, 在稻荷神社中可以看到许多尊狐狸的雕像。伏见稻荷神社具有悠久的渊源, 早于794年首都迁往京都。

箱根

- 箱根大涌谷-为300年前火山爆发的火山口, 每当起风时, 带着硫磺味的浓烟弥漫期间时, 形成特殊景观。登上山顶, 有用火山温泉煮熟的「黑鸡蛋」, 据日本人说吃一个可长寿7年。
- 平和公园-内有各种四季植物花卉和松树, 也有一座大型释迦牟尼之塔。
- 富士山-富士山海拔 3776 米, 是日本第一高峰。它气势雄伟, 为其它山峰所不及, 呈圆锥形的山姿十分优美, 常常被用来作为绘画和文学的创作题材, 它作为日本的象征, 名扬全世界。
- 芦之湖 海盗船-乘海盗船游览背倚着富士山的芦之湖, 湖山相映, 不同的季节有不同的景致和情趣。
- 忍野八海-由富士山雪水渗入地底后涌出的八个池子而形成的特别景观、是白佳名泉之一。加上以富士山为背景的美丽景致, 确实令人沉迷。

东京

- 浅草雷门观音寺-建于7世纪的佛庙, 其象征物是风雷神门, 上面挂着写有“雷门”两个大字的大红灯笼, 这里每天都有前来参拜的观光客, 终年熙熙攘攘。您也可在该寺前的热闹街道“仲见世”购物, 此处满布出售纪念品的小店及当地小吃的日式店铺。
- 皇居二重桥-它位於东京市中心, 护城河和石墙围绕著广大的绿地, 离东京车站仅数步之遥。日本皇室现居於此。皇居前的大广场称为皇居外苑, 游客可由皇居外苑观赏二重桥, 这两座桥是通往皇宫内的广场的入口处。
- 新宿歌舞伎町-东京都政府大楼、高楼大厦林立的事务所一条街。以购物、娱乐综合设施为中心的新宿, 被誉为不夜城的歌舞伎町为中心的日本少有的娱乐区。
- 迪士尼乐园-在迪斯尼正门的中心, 可以看到高耸的“灰姑娘城”这座主建筑, 然后在它的周围还建造了多种主题的游乐场和游乐馆, 有冒险宫、世界著名故事、传说宫、有风景宫、闲游宫、宇宙宫、幻想宫等。在东京迪士尼乐园里还可以看到大型的游行表演, 这些表演让您身同进入迪斯尼童话世界、并流连忘返。

Nara

- **Nara Todaiji** - is one of Japan's most famous temples and a landmark of Nara. Located in Nara Park, in central Nara, Todaiji was constructed in 752 as the head temple of all provincial Buddhist temples.
- **Deer Park** - is home to hundreds of freely roaming deer. Nara's nearly 1200 deer have become a symbol of the city and have been designated a natural treasure.

Osaka

- **Osaka Castle (Photo Stop)** - it is one of Japan's most famous castles.
- **Sinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** - a covered shopping street, liveliest and it lines with an interesting shop.

Kyoto

- **Heian Shrine** - has a relatively short history, dating back just over a hundred years to 1895. The shrine was built on the occasion of the 1100th anniversary of the capital's foundation in Kyoto and is dedicated to the spirits of the first and last emperors who reigned from the city, Emperor Kammu (737-806) and Emperor Komei (1831-1867). Heian is the former name of Kyoto.
- **Kyoto Kiyomizu Temple** - The temple is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple.
- **Gion Geisha District** - is Kyoto's most famous geisha district, with its high concentration of traditional wooden merchant houses.
- **Fushimi Inari Shrine** - is an important Shinto shrine in southern Kyoto. It is famous for its thousands of vermilion torii gates, which straddle a network of trails behind its main buildings. Fushimi Inari is the most important of several thousands of shrines dedicated to Inari, the Shinto god of rice. Foxes are thought to be Inari's messengers, resulting in many fox statues across the shrine grounds.

Hakone

- **Owakudani** - an area with active volcanic zone where sulphurous fumes, its "Black jewel eggs" cooked in the area's thermal heat sources, are a Hakone specialty.
- **Peace Park** - is a very beautiful and calm place, with Buddha's relics.
- **Mount Fuji** - Mt. Fuji, rising above the clouds, is the symbol of Japan and has provided a spiritual basis for the Japanese since ancient times, with the height of 3776m high.
- **Lake Ashi Pirate Ship** - was formed in the caldera of Mount Hakone after the volcano's last eruption 3000 years ago. And the boat ride could enjoy dreams and romance while gazing upon the delights of Mt. Fuji.
- **Oshino Hakkai** - is underground water from Mt. Fuji. It begins with the snow on the top of Mt. Fuji. The water travel over 80 years, and finally spring at Oshino Hakkai.

Tokyo

- **Sensoji (Asakusa Kanon Temple)** - The temple is dedicated to the god of mercy, Kanon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And you could walk along Nakamise Shopping Arcade, is bustling with people buying traditional Japanese snacks, which you could see many snack stalls demonstrate how they make it and then sell it still piping hot.
- **Imperial Palace** - formerly the Tokugawa family's residence, was opened in the Meiji Restoration and later re-named as the Imperial Palace, and it's famous for the Nijubashi Bridge in front of the main entrance.
- **Shinjuku Kabuki-cho** - is one of the 23 wards of Tokyo, but the name commonly refers just to the large entertainment, business and shopping area around Shinjuku Station. Handling more than two million passengers each day.
- **Tokyo Disneyland** - Tokyo Disneyland was the first Disney resort to be opened outside of America. The park is divided into 7 areas and the centerpiece of Tokyo Disneyland, like most Disney resorts, is Cinderella's Castle. Tokyo Disneyland places regularly as one of the top three most visited theme parks in the world.
